Everywhere we turn it seems there are communities in conflict and chaos around our world. We hear of families being separated from their homes or each other because of disasters. Maybe it is because of a volcanic eruption in Indonesia, or because of wars and political turmoil in Syria and East Africa, or because of violence on Central America.

In the midst of suffering and uncertainty, God pulls us, calls us, uses us to be compassion. We, the Church, are called to be God's compassion at work in the world, helping to rebuild and create a better world for all.

The world we are being called to create may seem beyond what we can imagine but it is a world God can imagine.

Through One Great Hour of Sharing we are creating, together, a world where families, have access to clean water, education and medical care—where they can find new homes without persecution; it is a world where there is shalom.
